NJCU Offices

Center for Career and Professional Development

The Center for Career and Professional Development provides comprehensive services and resources to research careers, find job opportunities, prepare for graduate school, improve resume writing and interviewing skills, and land appropriate internships for career advancement.

Center for Leadership and Engagement

The Center for Leadership and Engagement serves as a centralized connector, convener, and collaborator to provide students with the resources needed to improve leadership development and engagement on and off campus. This department also oversees student clubs and organizations, fraternities, and sororities.

Counseling Center

The Counseling Center offers currently enrolled NJCU students confidential mental health counseling, support groups, and workshops delivered by experienced professionals.

Health & Wellness Center

The Health and Wellness Center offers preventive and primary care services to help NJCU students stay healthy, regardless of insurance.

Office of Financial Aid

The Financial Aid office assists students in obtaining financial assistance for their education, including scholarships, grants, loans, and workstudy programs.
