

NJCU is pleased to offer health care coverage including medical, dental and prescription coverage to eligible employees through the New Jersey State Health Benefits Program. The Open Enrollment Period for New Jersey State Health Benefits Program (SHBP) is held once each year in October. All changes become effective for the next calendar year (January 1). Employees who wish to change their health and/or dental benefit plans and/or drop or add coverage for family members can do so during the annual open enrollment period.

## Prescription Plan

The Prescription Drug Program helps meet the cost of drugs prescribed for employees and their eligible dependents. There is a co-payment for each 30-day supply when purchased at a retail pharmacy. The copays vary based on health plan coverage and type of drug.

There is also a mail order component to the program designed for those taking prescription medications on an ongoing basis. The mail order program allows up to a 90 day supply of medication with various copays based on health plan coverage and type of drug.
