- The Hudson County Small Business Development Center at NJCU received an additional \$330,000 of CARES funding to provide assistance to small businesses impacted from COVID.




Guidance to Reopen Campuses

GEER Funding

- NJCU submitted its Grant application for the GEER Funds
- This application will also guide the Coronavirus Relief Funds the State will allocate.
- Overall, this is a pot of money of over 375M that OSHE will be appropriating amongst the institutions of higher education in the State of NJ

NJCU Pandemic Recovery Plan

There are 3 Main Themes as part of NJCU's Pandemic Recovery Plan. They are Safeguarding Measures & Priorities for the Safe Return to Campus for People, Places and Process

- 1) PEOPLE: Keeping People Healthy & Safe
Faculty, Staff and Students
- 2) PLACES: Instructional Space and Workplace Environment
Learning, Living and Working Spaces
- 3) PROCESS: Learning & Working
Remote Learning & Working
Preparation for Return to Campus
Hybrid & Face-to-Face Instruction Model



PEOPLE: Keeping people Healthy and Safe

Safe and Healthy practices:

- Wearing face masks that cover the mouth and nose
- Practicing social distancing (6 ft apart)
- Adhering to signage on campus - directional signage with arrows, waiting in a line, elevator capacity limits, restroom limits, etc.
- Wash hands for 20 seconds
- Clean and disinfect common surfaces

These are all important infection control strategies that we must practice every day when on campus

PLACES: Keeping Places Safe to Learn, Live and Work

Safeguarding measures being implemented:

- ✓ Floor markers & physical barriers (plastic shields/sneeze guards)
- ✓ Signage near elevators, bathrooms, lobby and other common areas to limit occupancy
- ✓ Enhanced cleaning protocols for cleaning and disinfection as per CDC
- ✓ Increased number of hands-free sanitizing stations
- ✓ High-efficiency air filters
- ✓ Increased ventilation rates

Processes: Keeping People Safe, Connected and Informed

Remote Learning & Working

- ✓ Blackboard, Zoom, Laptop distribution
- ✓ Medical Evaluations by Diligent, Testing and Contact Tracing
- ✓ Safety & Health Precautions set forth by CDC and OSHA
- ✓ Cleaning & Disinfecting Protocols (as per CDC)
- ✓ Signage & Communication for Compliance
- ✓ Training for Employees regarding Safe and Health Practices
- ✓ Protocol for spikes of infection on campus

Residence Life Updates

- 45 students living on campus this summer
 - In Vodra
 - No meal plans
- 316 applications received for 2020-21 housing
 - 239 returning students with completed applications and being assigned housing
 - Additional 30 in process of being completed
 - 77 new students with completed applications and being assigned housing
 - Still early in the cycle/process for new students
 - 48 applications in process of being completed




Fall 2020 Residence Life Plans

- Each student with their own bedroom
 - 369 with current configurations
 - Possibility to add more by converting lounges
- In conversations with hotels for overflow options
 - Students will pay same rate as if on campus
- Experience will be different

Residence Life Rules / Regulations

- COVID testing for all residential students
- No outside visitors allowed (even between halls)
- Enhanced cleaning protocols
 - Sanitizer and Disinfecting Spray available everywhere
- Lounge/Gathering spaces closed or reduced capacity (social distancing)

Summer Camp

- Official Start: Monday, July 6th
- Six-week summer experience with themed weeks and block scheduling
- Max 25 campers per cohort
- Mandatory pre-screening and daily temperature checks
- Additional outdoor space: Hepburn Lawn, Metro Field and JMAC Parking lots



Total Fall Sport Student-Athletes (220 out of 325)


- July 1-15 – Conduct telemedicine visit with Diligent Urgent Care.
 - July 15-22 – Complete PCR or antibody test (Receive results within one week).
 - July 30, 31 and August 3, 4 – Conduct on-campus physicals with RWJ
 - August 10 – Begin Voluntary Fall Training Camp
 - August 16 – Move in day
 - August 17 – Begin Mandatory Fall training Camp
- Daily temperature check and pre-screening will be in place
 - Potential week delay to start Fall competition
 - New Jersey Athletic Conference (NJAC) Medical Protocols



Transfer Registration/Enrollment Update





Graduate Registration/Enrollment Update





Summer Enrollment Update




