



## 2024-2025 EOF PROGRAM ELIGIBLITY DOCUMENT CHECKLIST

## To be considered for an EOF graduate grant, applicants must:

- 1. File the 2024-2025 FAFSA or NJ Alternative Financial Aid Application NJCU School Code: 002613
- 2. Submit a completed and signed <u>2024-2025 Verification Worksheet</u>.
- 3. Submit the following documents.
  - o 2021 & 2022 federal income tax forms or IRS Tax Transcripts
    - If your parents filed separately but are still married, the filing status for 2022 must indicate "Married Filing Separately."
    - If your parent(s)/guardian(s) own a home, you must provide:
      - A 2021 & 2022 "Mortgage Bank Loan Statement" (showing the Principal Balance Owed on the house)
      - o A 2021 & 2022 "Tax Assessment Statement" (from your local City Hall)
  - o Copy of Student's Social Security Card
  - o Proof of non-taxable income (if applicable)
    - Social Security Benefits (SSDI/SSI)- Submit a 1099 Form or letter from the Social Security Administration stating the **total dollar amount** received in 2021 & 2022.
    - Welfare Benefits- Submit a letter from Welfare Services stating the **total dollar amount** received in welfare benefits for the year 2021 & 2022.
    - Child Support- Submit a letter from the Court stating the <u>total</u> dollar amount received in child support for the year 2021 & 2022.
  - o Proof of Citizenship or eligible non-citizen status (except NJ Alternate Financial Aid applicants)
    - If you are a citizen of the United States, submit one of the following documents:
      - o US Birth Certificate
      - US Passport
      - Certificate of Naturalization
    - If you are an eligible non-citizen, submit one of the following documents:
      - Alien Registration Card (Green Card)
      - o I-94 Departure Document
      - o Passport with (INS) stamp
      - o Asylum/Refugee Document
