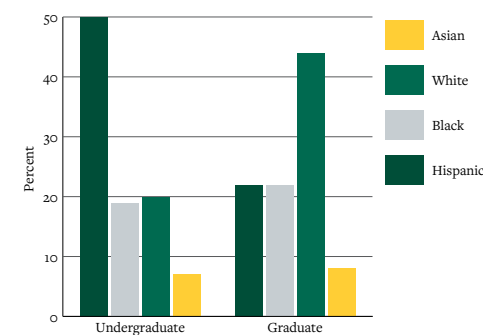

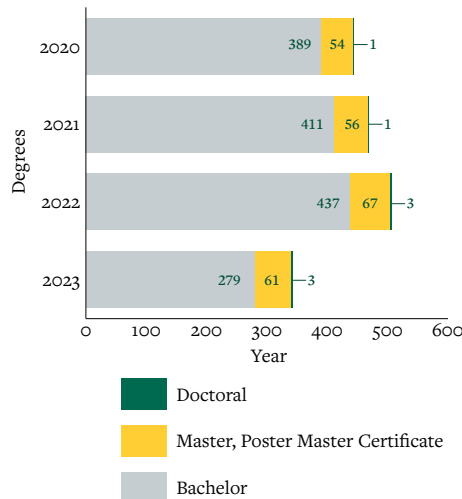
UNDERGRADUATE ONE-YEAR SUCCESS RATE
