




Using Anthology Portfolio for Course Assessment


To begin, you will need to create an assignment link in Blackboard which will link to Portfolio. Navigate to the Blackboard course and your Course Content.















13 Click the drop-down menu for Department and choose College of Education. Choose your program from the drop-down menu for Group.
