Whereas on April, 20th, 2020, NJCU's University Senate voted to revise the General Education Program by 1) reducing the credit requirements by nine, and 2) replacing the requirement that students take two courses in each mode of inquiry with the requirement that students take two courses in each student learning outcoming;

Whereas the criteria used to evaluate new General Education course proposals have yet to be updated to reflect these changes;

Whereas the criteria used to evaluate proposals to change existing General Education courses have yet to be updated to reflect these changes;

Whereas the General Education Curriculum Committee needs further time to propose new criteria for such reviews to the Senate;

Whereas any approved revisions to these criteria must be programmed into the Course Leaf Software;

Whereas General Education courses are currently being evaluated in the absence of updated criteria.

Now, therefore, be it resolved that:

1. Evaluations at all stages in the approval process of a new General Education course submitted before January, 1st, 2022 shall be conducted using the criteria and processes that existed for such evaluations on April, 19th, 2020.
2. Evaluations at all stages in the approval process of a revision to a pre-existing General Education course submitted before January, 1st, 2022 shall be conducted using the criteria and processes that existed for such evaluations on April, 19th, 2020.
