<b>Full Course Title</b>	Global Threat Assessment: Public & Private Sectors
<b>Credits</b>	3.0
<b>Course Level</b>	600 level (Graduate)
<b>Catalog Description</b>	This graduate course explores important risk mitigation themes in international security. Through the analysis of geopolitical issues, environmental disasters, crime and social activism, technology, privacy, workplace violence, and extremism, this course will examine Global Security and the art and science of keeping people and property safe in the 21st century.
