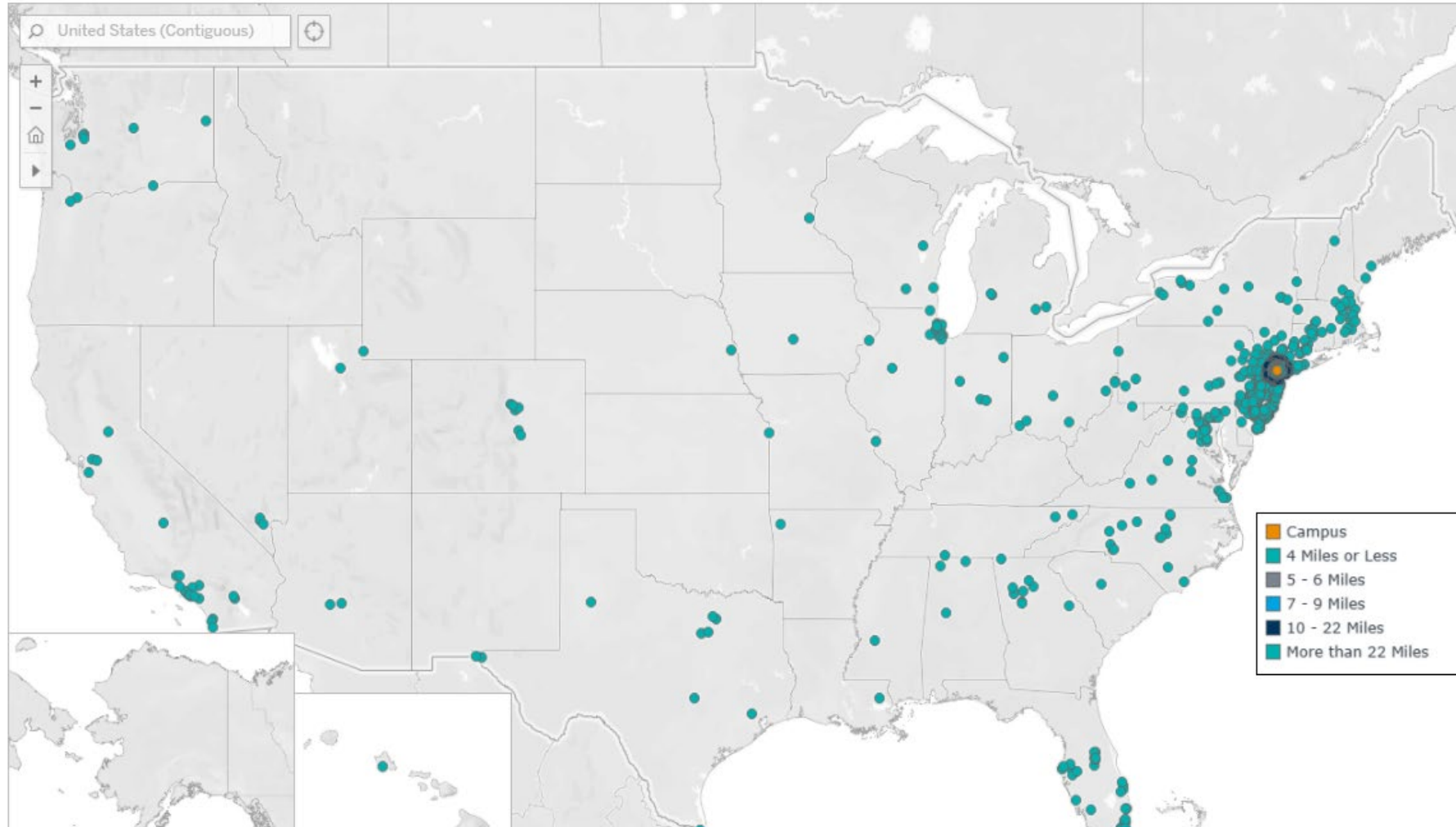

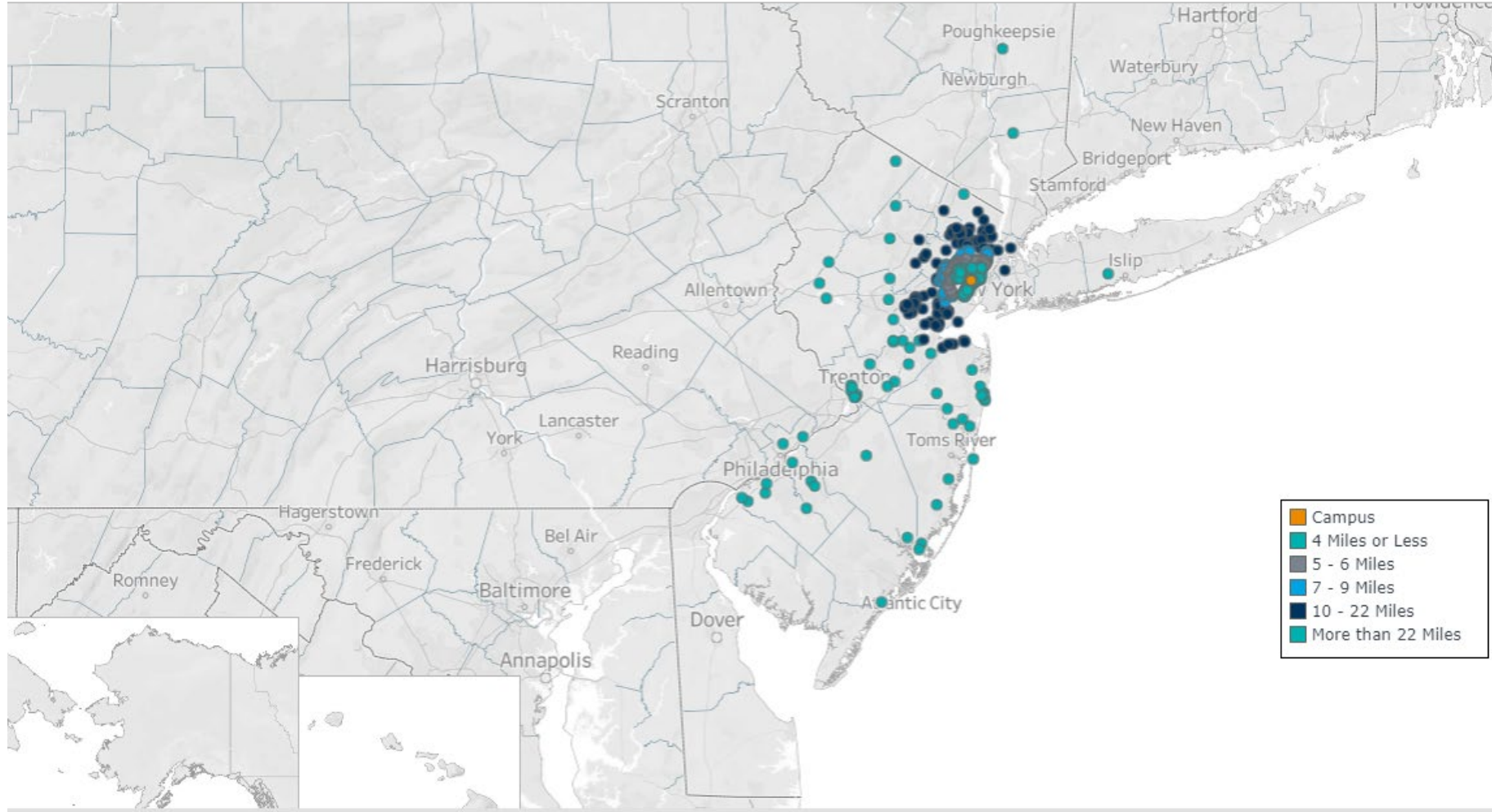
Admits by Distance from Campus

Full-Time Freshman



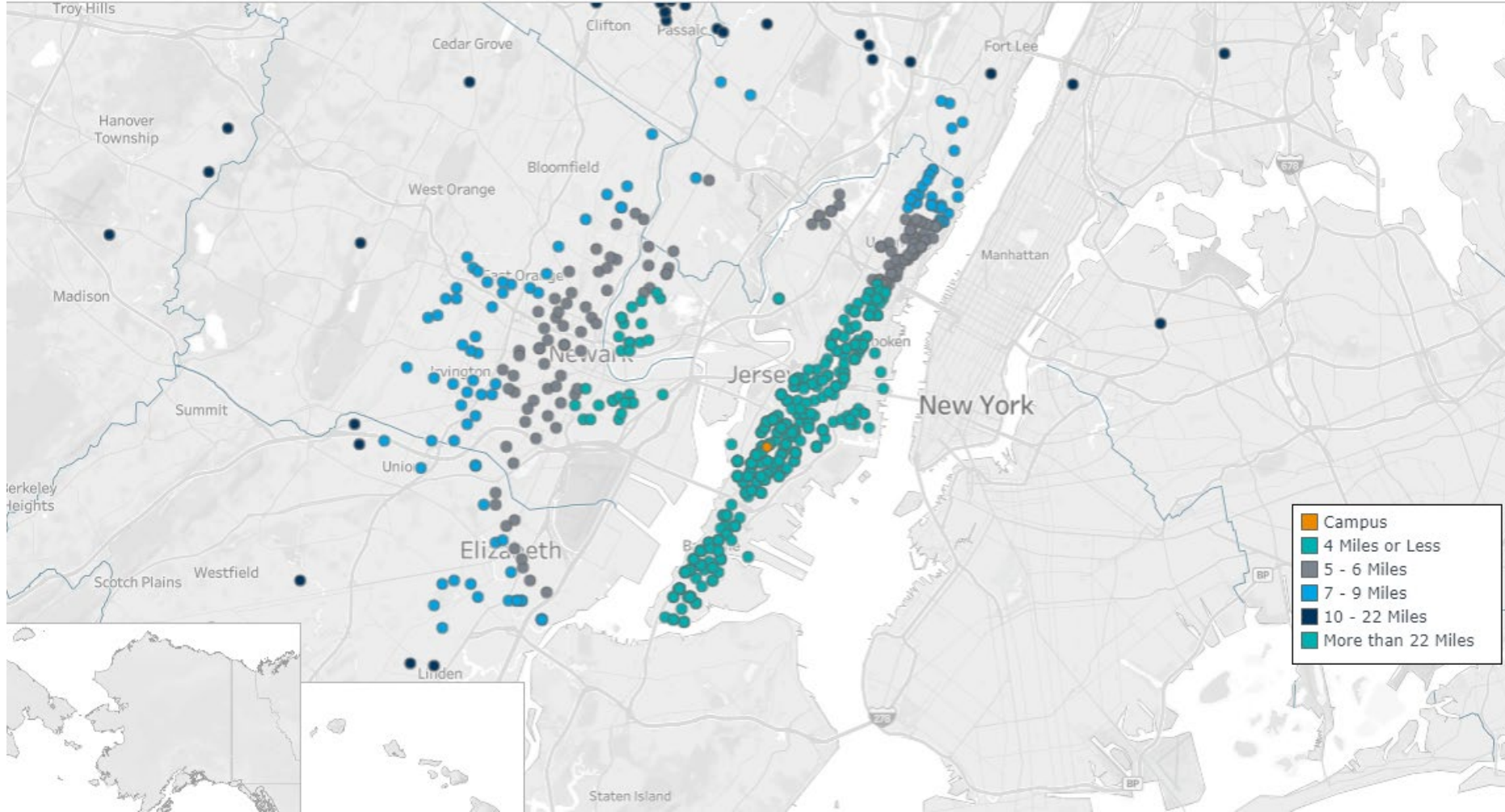
Enrolled by Distance from Campus

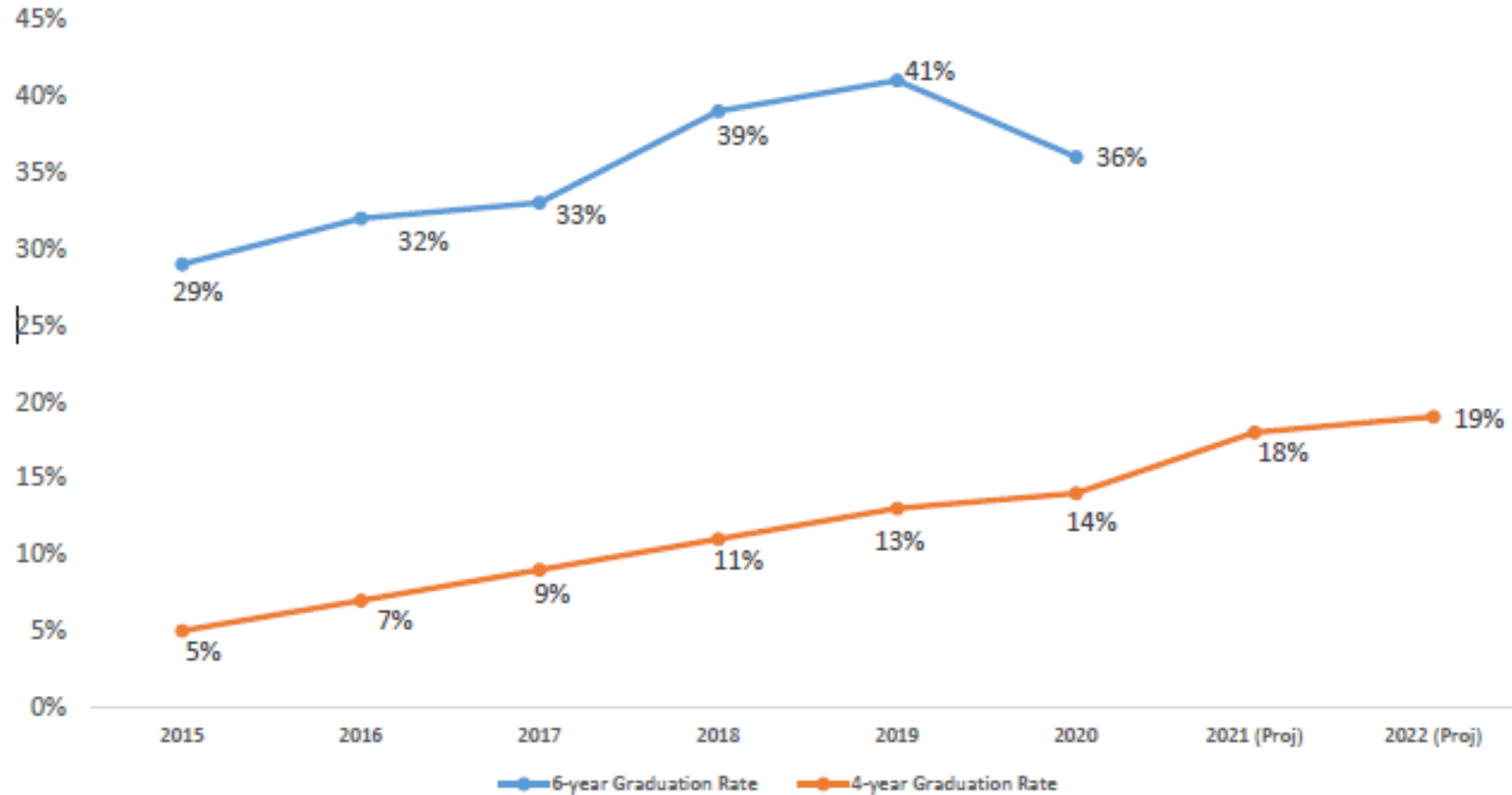


Enrolled by Distance from Campus

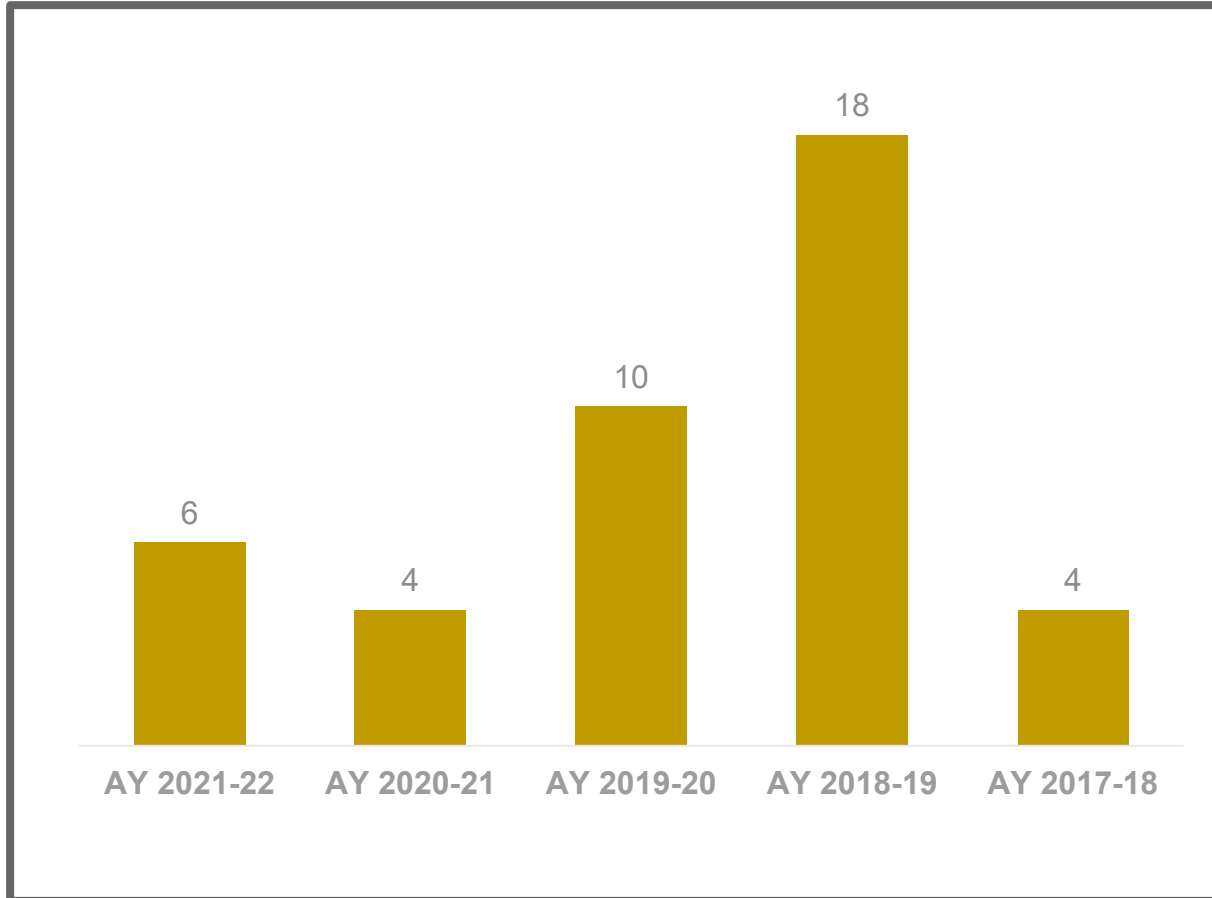

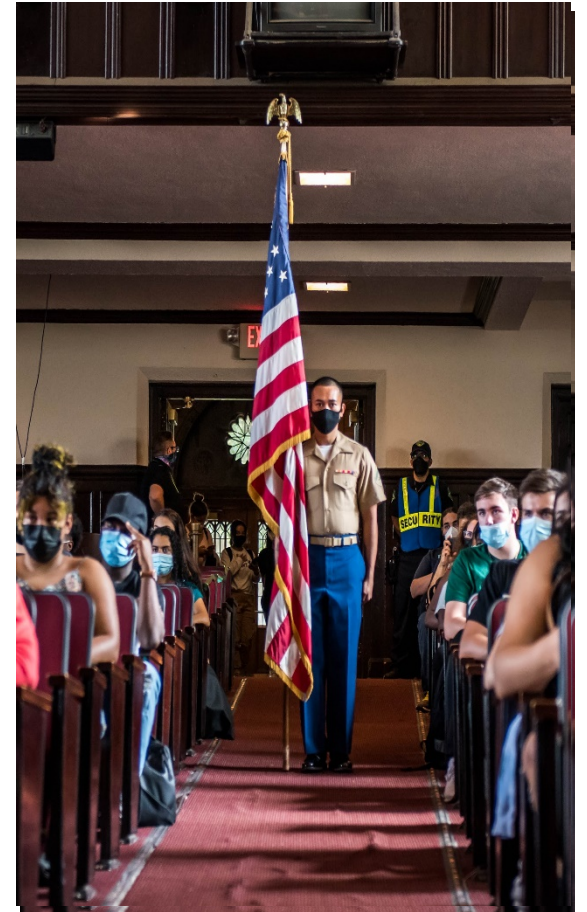

NJCU was one of several four-year institutions as part of the Brookdale Communiversities launched years ago where we could only offer limited programs and work with Brookdale students.

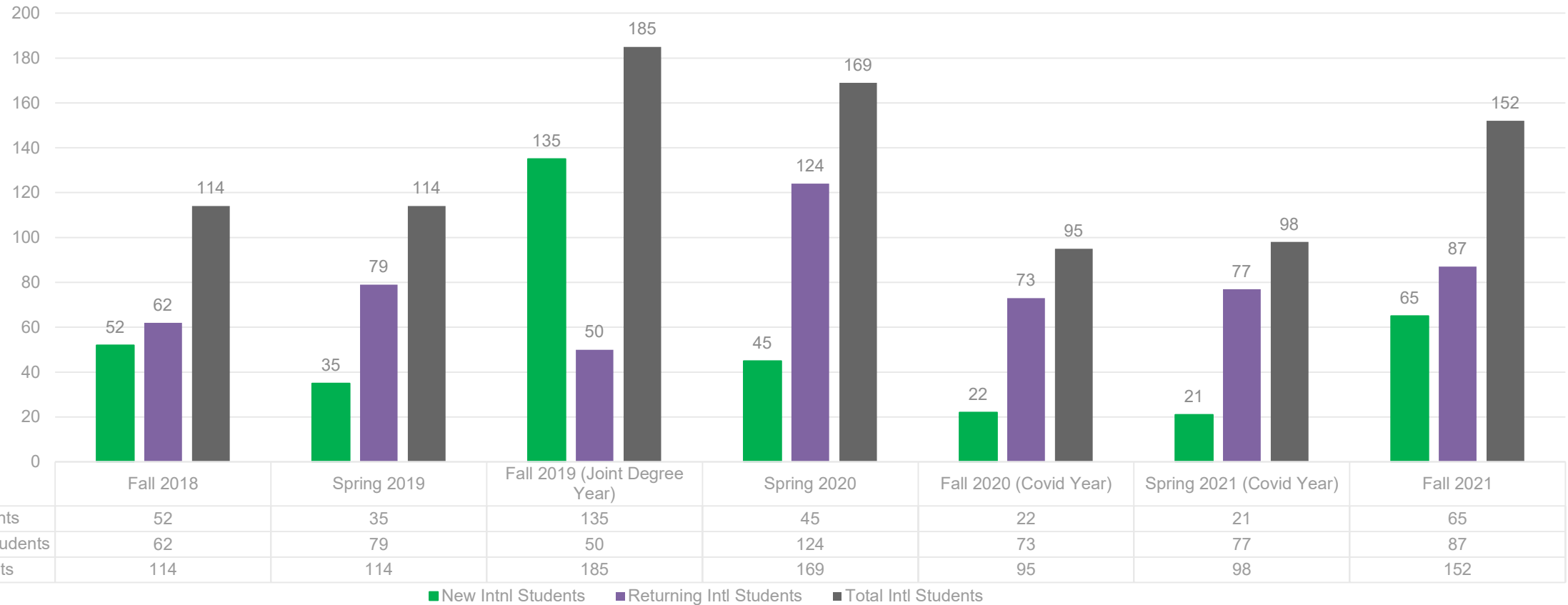
